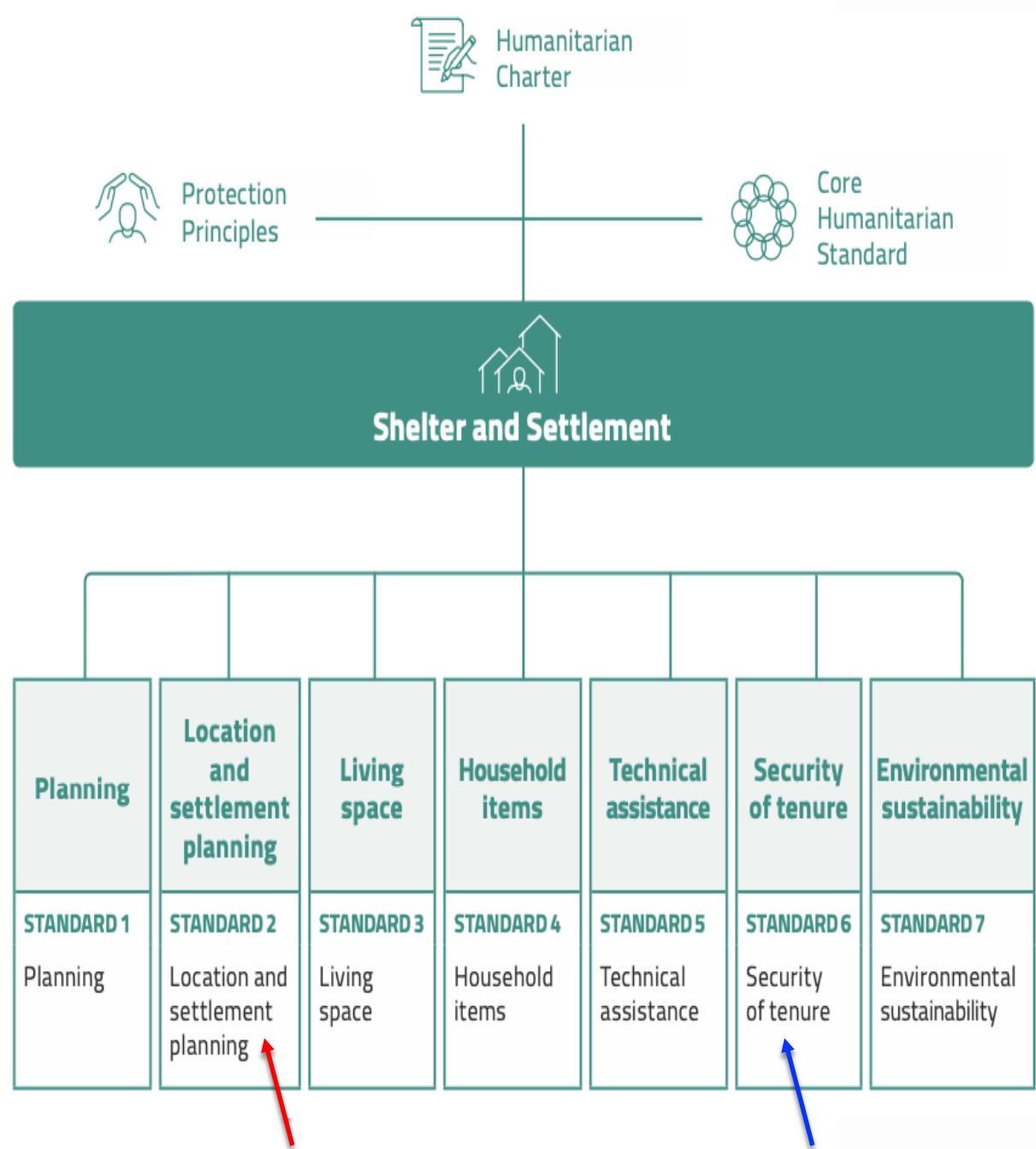


**FIGURE 6: DECISION TREE: WHEN TO USE CASH TRANSFERS.**



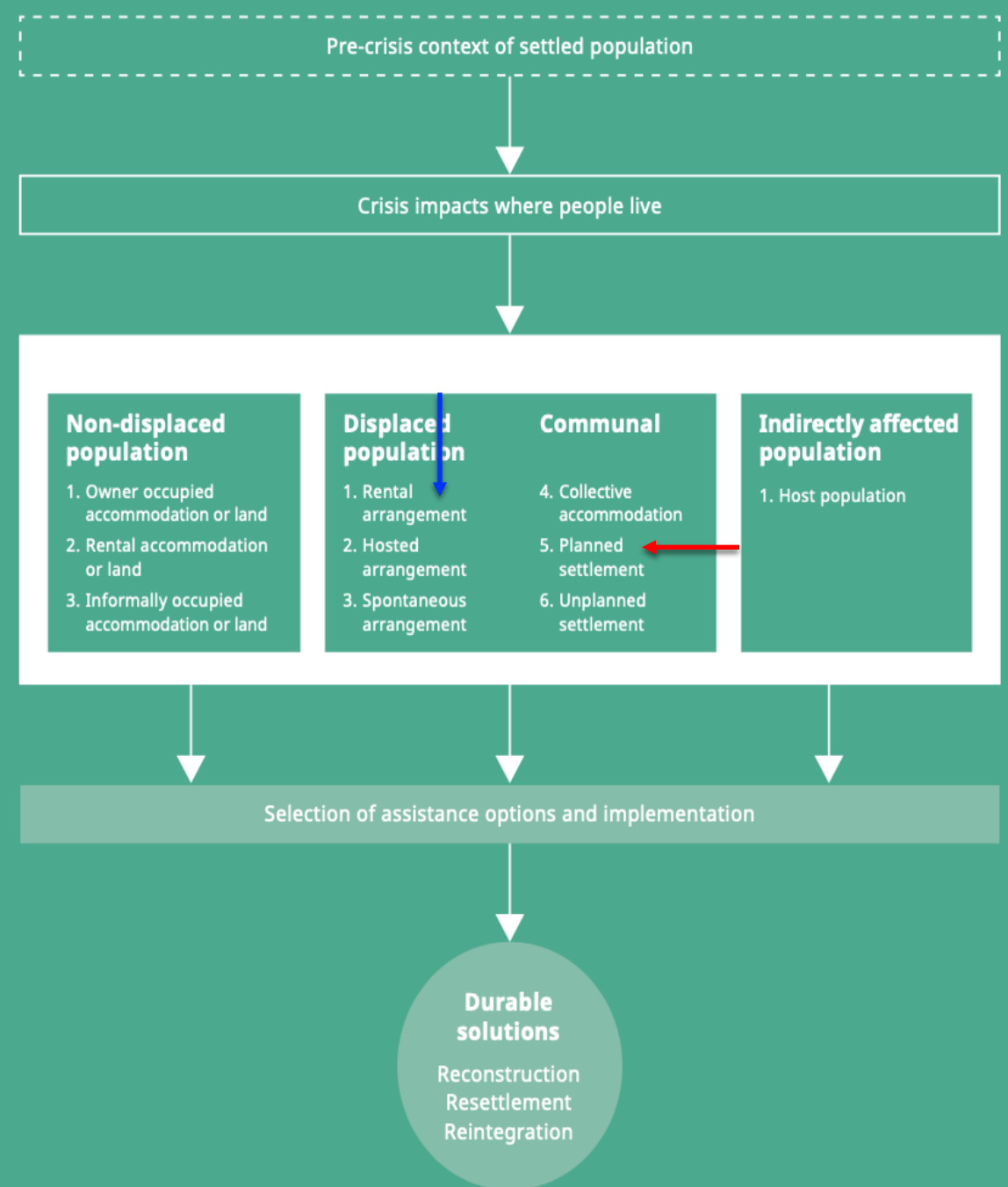

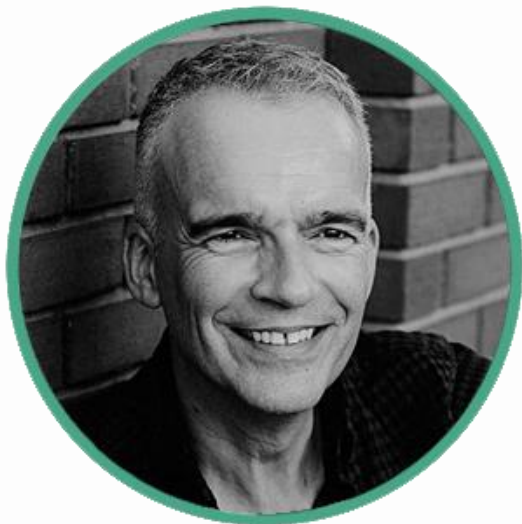
